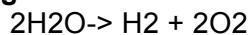

Fueling the car - An overview of basics of electrolysis

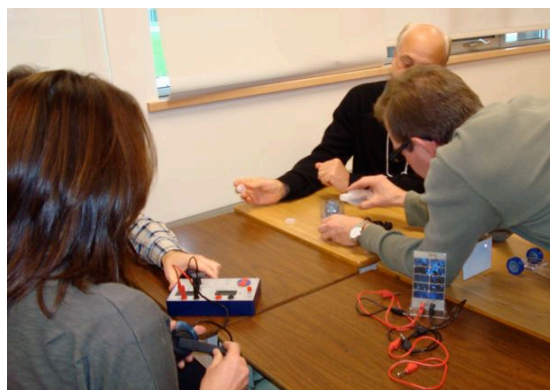


In-class Activities:

- Dynamos + Voltmeters
- Explore electrical current
- Charge your fuel cell (via electrolysis)

Hydrogen Fuel Cells - How exactly do they work?

- $2\text{H}_2 \rightarrow 4\text{H}^+ + 4\text{e}^-$ (moving electrons = current)
- Platinum is the catalyst
- Water is the bi-product = $4\text{H}^+ + \text{O}_2 \rightarrow 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$



Final Activity: Fuel Cell car races:

- Ask students to explore the differences in car performance.
- Should car speed or distance travelled be the same for all cars?
- What impact does charging the fuel cell car have on its performance?
