They have three minutes to complete four mini challenges. Teams accumulate points by successfully completing the various challenges within the allotted time.

One of the major goals of the course is to promote an interest in engineering / technologically based careers. The course has taught students basic computer programming as well as elements of robotic design while reinforcing concepts of physics, math, effective problem solving, critical thinking, and teamwork skills.
